

Courses in France and Spain for Primary School Teachers of French / Spanish

A cross-curricular approach is favoured and all activities are transferable to the teaching of other Modern Foreign Languages.

Follow-up

Teachers will receive a certificate at the end of the week. Teachers will also have the opportunity to join a Europe-wide network of all participants.

Fee

The total cost of the course is €1,650 (**€900 for subsistence, €750 for tuition fee**), **payable to LFEE after receipt of the Comenius grant. The course fee covers:**

- Accommodation in individual room
- Full board
- Registration and tuition fees
- Cultural excursions
