Who Certifies the Course?

Certification is by the Advisory Council for English Language Schools. A.C.E.L.S. operates under the aegis of the Department of Education & Science and regulates state recognised English language teaching in Ireland. Successful course participants are enfranchised to work in the junior EFL sector.
